

Pollen Control Ordinance Summary

§ 9-12-2 et seq

Becomes effective August 1, 1997

RESTRICTED PLANTS

Regulates or prohibits Growing, Sale, Importation and Planting of these genera, except as noted:

- *Cupressus* (Cypress)
- *Morus* (mulberry)
- *Ulmus* (elm)
- *Juniperus* (juniper)
 - Known female varieties and any variety not exceeding 2 feet high at maturity are allowed.
- *Populus* (poplar, cottonwood, aspen) - prohibited except:
 - *P. fremontii* var. *wislizeni* (Rio Grande cottonwood)
 - *P. tremuloides* (quaking aspen)
 - *P. acuminata* (lance leaf cottonwood)

The following high-pollen genera are specifically exempted and may be planted without restriction:

- *Platanus* (sycamore, London plane tree)
- *Fraxinus* (ash)

MAJOR ELEMENTS

- I. Requires consumer labeling for allergenic pollen production and water consumption.**

Provides direction to adequately sample and measure the pollen content of the air within the City using state-of-the-art equipment.

Pollen Control Ordinance

ENFORCEMENT

- Primarily through compliance of wholesale and retail nursery industry.
 - Party will have 7 days from notification to come into compliance without penalty
 - Failure to comply within 7 days will result in further enforcement action.
