SUBJECT: CPA-DISTRICTS - ANNUAL DISTRICT AGREEMENTS REVIEW

To: Leadership Team
District Conservationists

New Mexico NRCS and Soil and Water Conservation Districts (SWCD) work together providing conservation through a Cooperative Working Agreement (CWA) and a Mutual Agreement (MA). These agreements outline how the two organizations operate and coordinate efforts and resources.

All District Conservationists are being directed to review their District's CWA and MA at the next SWCD board of supervisors meeting. DCs are also to insure that the minutes reflect the review. Copies of CWA and MA should be provided to each board member.


Special emphasis should be placed on the Civil Rights section by reviewing the current USDA Non-Discrimination Statement (below). District Conservationists are also to encourage their district(s) to maintain, and/or work towards a diverse membership that reflects the community makeup, and to recruit or appoint minorities, females and persons with disabilities.

USDA Non-Discrimination Statement

District Conservationists are to report back to their Area Conservationist when the above have been completed. Both the CWA and the MA must be filed as, "District Agreements", file code 180-11-11.
