Summary. Beneficial insects (i.e beneficial bugs) are any species of insects that perform valued services like pollination and insect pest control. This technical note provides an insect pest control strategy; by encouraging beneficial insects which control the pest species. This strategy is often used in organic farming or gardening, or as part of an Integrated Pest Management (IPM) plan.
